#### **Register a New Account**

To perform any account related action on **GetMeKnown** (<u>http://www.getmeknown.co.za/</u>) you'll need an account, and creating one is quite easy. To start head over to <u>http://www.getmeknown.co.za/account/register and</u> start the process. Reminder that you are the injector and to use your own id no. or your KUSA/Other membership number.

#### **Register a Microchip**

After you have created a account you will need to Login (<u>http://www.getmeknown.co.za/account/login</u>), this is done by providing the E-Mail Address you used to register and the password for your account. To create a Microchip click on "**Register Microchip**" and follow the directions on the next screen. You will then be asked to provide your Microchip Number. A Microchip Numbers consists of 15 Digits. Please verify correctness. Complete all the required fields. To view all your registered pets just click "account".

#### **Print or e-mail Certificates**

Once you have completed a registration of a microchip you can view, print or e-mail the certificate. Should you need a copy at a later stage just login to your account and press "Certificate" next to the desired microchip number.

#### Transfer ownership of a microchip

To Receive Ownership of a Microchip you will need to Make a Request and wait for the current owner to login and then approve your request. **No need to type in any information about the Pet.** Login to your account, then in the Main Menu on your profile page select "Request Ownership". Type in the 15 digit microchip number. You will be redirected to a page where you can review the details of the pet click "Request a Transfer of Ownership" the request will be sent you just need to wait for the current owner to accept.
